Calendar and Credit

CSU offers multiple term structures, including accelerated formats. The unit of credit is the semester hour. One (1) credit hour requires a minimum of 45 hours of student work, with 15 hours focused on academic engagement and 30 hours focused on student preparation.

Graduation Requirements

A 2.0 GPA is required for undergraduate students, and a 3.0 is required for graduate students to be eligible for graduation. All other program requirements must also be met.

Graduation Honors

A cumulative "honors GPA" is calculated by combining all coursework attempted at CSU. Students must have no grade lower than a "C", must not have been found in violation of the Academic Integrity Policy, and must not have repeated any course taken at CSU due to non-satisfactory grades. Honors recognition is only awarded for bachelor's degree programs.

The following minimum GPAs are required for honors recognition:
